## Orienteering Map

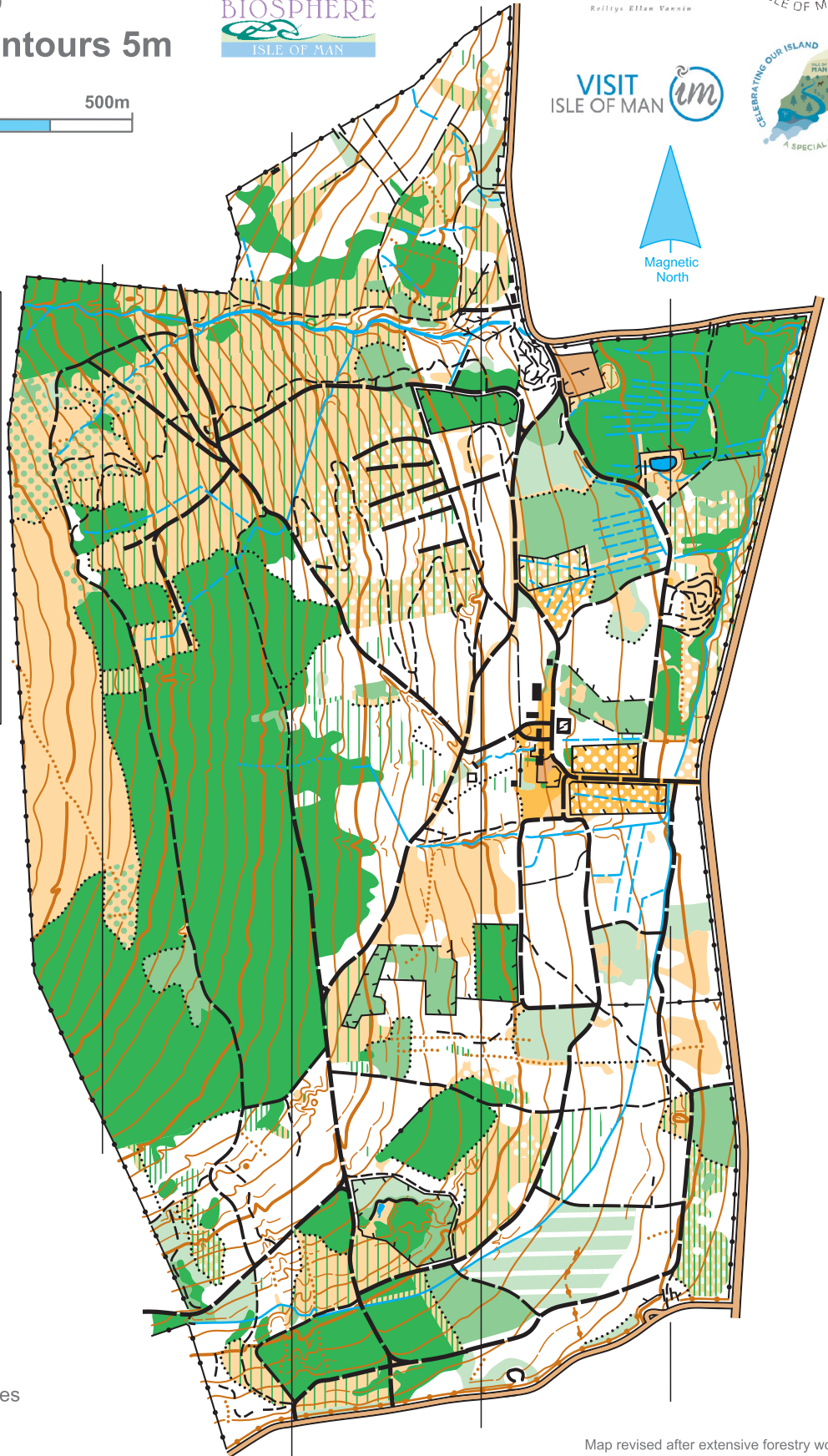
